I love you, My precious ones, My children who follow Me faithfully, who give your lives for Me. You are true heroes in My sight, and will be remembered for many generations to come. (1)

If you were able to see what I have in store for each sacrifice you have made, you would be willing to make every single one. But you won't be able to see your reward in full until your service for Me on Earth is over, so I say to you what I said to My disciples when I was on Earth, "Blessed are those who having not seen have believed. Great is their faith!" (2)

Your earthly life's greatest peak of glory will be the day when I bring you Home to Me and richly reward you before all creation, as I say to you, "Well done, My good and faithful servants! Enter into the joy of the Lord! (3)

The departed saints and spirit beings of Heaven applaud and praise. "Who are they praising for?" For you! These are the sounds you will be greeted with one day in Heaven when you have come home to your reward. You will be the center of commendation and praise--not just commendation for a job well done, not just praise for your faithfulness and love for Me, but specific and special praise for your battle wounds. One day I will display before all of Heaven all those battle wounds that you received in hand-to-hand combat with the forces of Hell, and in that day each scar will be as an honor, glory, a mark of dedication and loyalty, a beautiful thing in the spirit. (4)

Your battle wounds really will glow. The trials and difficulties you endured will have grown your faith, and the more faith you have, the richer you are in the spiritual realm. Don't let them get you down. Know that great is your reward in Heaven. (5)

A man or woman who gives everything has no regrets at the end of life. They'll know that they did everything they could, fought as hard as they could, and My grace will have seen them through any obstacles they faced for as long as they faced them.

If you can say with Paul at the end of your days, "I have fought a good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith," then you will have been the kind of fighter I need. Paul didn't say, "I've won every battle, I've defeated every enemy, I've destroyed the heathen rule of the Roman Empire," did he? He said, "I've kept the faith. I've fought a good fight. I finished the course" (2Tim.4:7). He didn't finish the war, but he did finish his course, his run, his part. If you can say the same when you get to Heaven, then you will have run the race as I wanted it

run, fought the war as you should, done your best for Me, and there will be a great reward laid up for you for having done your part. Your job on Earth will be done, you'll have completed My mission for you, and you'll hear Me say, "Well done, good and faithful servant; enter into the joy of your Lord!"

Those words are worth it, the reward is worth it, the ultimate victory is worth it. So fight well and keep fighting till the end of whatever battle I call you to fight, great or small, long or short, temporary or terminal. To the end, My friends, whatever that end might be.-Victory in this life, or victory in the spirit, either way you win! (6)

When I welcome you Home to Heaven, what are the words I have promised to say to you if you have given your all and pleased Me on Earth? Are the first words out of My lips going to be, "My, how successful you were, how much you got done, how hard you worked, what glorious accomplishments precede you"? Or are My words going to be, "Well done, good and faithful servant"?

I don't look at how much you accomplished. I don't look at all that you did for Me. In fact, that's one of the last things on the list of deeds worthy of rewards with Me. I don't look at how great you were and how few faults and mistakes you had. All I look at is how you obeyed, loved Me, and did what I asked you to do.

This is the difference between how I see things and how you see them. I see you as successful and accomplished by your faithfulness, through your perseverance, dedication, and getting up from your falls again and again to accomplish My will for you. (7)

(Dad speaking:) In spite of the times when it looked like you might not make it, you kept on going! Even if the only thing you were standing on was blind faith alone, you stayed faithful, loyal and true. Some of you folks might have felt like giving up at one time or another, but you didn't, and that's what makes the difference! You may have experi-enced times when you felt like you were in a fog that was so thick you couldn't see your hand in front of your face! But you didn't let that stop you. You kept on going by faith. You trusted that the fog would lift and you'd see the sun shine once again, and you have!

You kept on fighting! You kept on believing! You didn't give up and wave the white flag of sickening surrender when the Devil was hitting you hard. Instead, you stood up and yelled in his face! You hit him back, you fought and won! You were determined to fight on at any cost, because you knew the Lord expected it of you, and you did it! You're still here to tell about it, and that's what counts. (8)

Know that these sufferings and afflictions, though they are great and though they weigh upon you, can't even be compared to the glory that will be revealed in you. You will be glorious! You will shine forever as one of My valiant soldiers, My valiant knights who fought the battles of the Lord and overcame the attacks of the Enemy, one who rescued many of My lost sheep from the clutches of the Evil One and brought them safely Home to Me. Forever your name will be written in the stars--the stars that shall shine from your crown because you have turned many to Me and have been faithful to My calling and anointing. (9) I'm giving you full credit for everything that you endure for Me, for everything that you overcome. Someday each trial will be a special mark of admiration, like a medal on a well-decorated officer. Each of these things you fought through while remaining faithful to Me and to the calling I gave you will add to your credit. I'll be so proud of you when you come Home to Me, and I'll announce to everyone as I give you your reward:

This one had a tough road to follow on Earth. He felt called to serve Me, and despite the setbacks, despite the challenges, despite all the things that would have made a lesser person give up and stop trying, this faithful disciple never stopped. He kept giving Me the best he could. He gave Me whatever time he could manage. He supported My work the best he was able. He shared My love with others whenever possible. I have seen his heart and what he gave up to serve Me. Therefore, I give him My high commendation. (10)

When I look upon you, sweet ones, I don't see your lacks, your mistakes, your problems, or your hesitations. I don't judge you by the areas in which you feel you fall short. I judge you by your love for Me and your desire to do My will. You've been faithful. You've been loyal. You've been through the fire of afflictions and battles, and yet you fight on. You've had your doubts, your times of seeming defeat, your times of discouragement, yet through all of these times you've remained under the shadow of My wings. You've stood by My side when others disowned Me. You've given your all when some others would only have given a part. You've trusted Me with your life, your marriage, your love, your happiness, and your children--this is why I'm proud of you. (11)

When I gather all of you, My Endtime Family, to My arms in Heaven, then I will bring you all to a specially prepared auditorium, and I will show you then and there how your presence on Earth--individually and collectively as a Family--has changed the world. Then you will see all the little things that escape your eyes now. The discouragement will vanish. The tears will be wiped away, never to return. You'll see tangible proof of how your labors went before you, changing hearts and lives and giving ¬others a chance to receive or to reject. You'll see that you have done the job, that you've been faithful, and that I'm so pleased with you. (12)

I long for the day and the moment when I will gather you up into My arms. I will thank you

and reward you for the love that you've given to others, the faithfulness with which you've served Me, and the hardships you've endured for Me. Though you were tired, you continued to run the race. And know this, that there is laid up for you a crown of righteousness. There is a treasure and a crown of many stars that awaits your coming before My throne. (14)

My life and ministry was that of a servant, for I had come to seek and save others. In many ways I was what you would call an unsung hero--one who did not receive the praise and recognition that was his due. Only those who knew Me well and could see and sense things in the spirit knew the truth of what was going on. So it is today that many of My children who lead what look like rather quiet, uneventful, less-than-spectacular lives, who have ministries that are not in the limelight, are also unsung heroes. (Dad speaking:) If you could only see the end of the road! If you could only see what the Lord has in store for you, it would give you such strength to carry on! If you could only see the reward that He has laid up for you because of your faithful service and your sacrifice and your willingness to be what He wants you to be. (18)

(Dad speaking:) So hold on! Don't let go! Keep the crown! Fight the fight! Win the war and receive your reward! For great is your reward in Heaven! Great is the reward of those who overcome, those who fight to the finish. I know it's a struggle! I know it's a fight! But let me

tell you, I struggled the struggle, I fought the fight, and I know now it is well worth it. For the rewards are far greater than anything you could ever think or imagine! (19)

(Jesus:) Go someplace quiet, somewhere you can get comfortable and close your eyes. I want you to picture Heaven and take a few moments to imagine what your heavenly mansion will be like, and how you would like it to be structured if you were the designer. Think about the style of the architecture, the location and scenery you would like to be surrounded by, whether it be a graceful house with large windows located on a cliff overlooking the ocean, or a cozy log cabin in a green forest, or a mansion where your friends and loved ones all live on the same street. Get detailed about what colors you like, what scents and smells you want wafting through the halls, what flowers and wildlife you want in or surrounding your mansion, etc. Picture it all in your mind's eye and then imagine walking through the halls of this beautiful mansion with Me by your side, giving you everything that your heart desires and wishes for since you were so faithful to delight yourself in Me. They'll have access to certain libraries and levels of Heaven that others are not permitted into. They will be ahead and be able to do things such as lead exciting pioneer trips to other planets. When there's a new push, they'll be right in on the groundwork meetings.

You can relate that to the way that those with the most money and experience on Earth are able to obtain the coolest gadgets for both work and play. Not everything in Heaven is work.
