1. We will sing unto Thee, O Lord, for Thou hast triumphed gloriously:

**2.** Thou art our strength & our song, & Thou hast become our Salvation: and we will prepare Thee an habitation; & we will exalt Thee.

**3.** Thou art a man of war: The Lord is Thy Name.

**4.** The depths hath covered our enemies: They have sunk into the bottom as the stone.

**5.** Thy right hand, O Lord, is become glorious in power: Thy right hand, O Lord, hath dashed in pieces the Enemy.

**6.** In the greatness of Thy excellency Thou hast overthrown them that rose up against Thee: Thou sentest forth Thy wrath, which consumed them as

stubble.

**7.** Who is like unto Thee, O Lord? Who is like Thee, glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, doing wonders?

**8.** Thou in Thy mercy hast led forth the people which Thou hast redeemed: Thou hast guided them in Thy strength unto Thy holy habitation.

**9.** Thou shalt bring them in, & plant them in the mountain of Thy inheritance, in the place, O Lord, which Thou hast made for Thee to dwell in, in Thy Sanctuary, O Lord, which Thy hands have established.

**10.** And Thou shalt reign for ever & ever.

11. We sing unto Thee, O Lord, for Thou hast triumphed gloriously.

12. Thou art our rock, & our fortress, & our deliverer;

**13.** The God of our rock; in Thee will we trust: Thou art our shield & the horn of our Salvation, our high tower, & our refuge, our Saviour; Thou savest us from violence.

14. We will call upon Thee, Who art worthy to be praised: So shall we be saved from our enemies.

**15.** We glory in Thy holy Name: Our hearts greatly rejoice in Thy Salvation.

16. For Thou art great, & greatly to be praised.

**17.** Glory & honour are in Thy presence; strength & gladness are in Thy place.

**18.** We give thanks unto Thee, O God, for Thou art good, & Thy mercy endureth for ever.

**19.** Blessed be Thy Name for ever & ever.

**20.** Blessed be Thou, Lord God of Israel our Father, for ever & ever.

**21.** Thine, O Lord, is the greatness, & the power, & the glory, & the victory, & the majesty: For all that is in the Heaven & in the Earth is Thine; Thine is the Kingdom, O Lord, & Thou art exalted as head above all.

**22.** Both riches & honour come of Thee, & Thou reignest over all; & in Thine hand is power & might; & in Thine hand it is to make great, & to give strength unto all.

**23.** Now therefore, our God, we thank Thee, & praise Thy glorious Name.

24. All things come of Thee, & of Thine Own have we given Thee.

**25.** Thou art our praise, & Thou art our God, & hast done for us these great & terrible things, which our eyes have seen.

**26.** Blessed be Thy glorious Name, which is exalted above all blessing & praise.

27. Thou, even Thou, art Lord alone; & Thou hast made Heaven, the Heaven of heavens, with all their hosts, the Earth, & all things that are therein, the seas, & all that is therein, & Thou preservest them all; & the host of Heaven worshippeth Thee.

**28.** Behold, Thou art our Salvation; we will trust, & not be afraid; for Thou art our strength & our song; & hast also become our Salvation.

**29.** We will praise Thee, O Lord, & call upon Thy Name. We will declare Thy doings among the people, & make mention that Thy Name is exalted.

**30.** We will sing unto Thee, Lord, for Thou hast done excellent things which are known throughout all the Earth.

**31.** We will cry out & shout, for Thou, O Lord, art great in the midst of us.

**32.** We will lift up our voices to Thee, O God, & sing for Thy majesty, O Lord.

**33.** Thou art our God; we will exalt Thee, we will praise Thy Name; for Thou hast done wonderful things; Thy counsels of old are faithfulness & Truth.

**34.** We will sing unto Thee a new song, & Thy praise unto the ends of the Earth.

**35.** Blessed be Thy Name, O God, for ever & ever: For wisdom & might are Thine.

**36.** We thank Thee, & praise Thee, O Thou God of our fathers, Who hast given us wisdom & might, & Who hast made known unto us the treasures of Thy Word.

**37.** We praise & extol & honour Thee, O God. Thy works are Truth, & Thy ways judgement.

**38.** We will sacrifice unto Thee with the voice of thanksgiving; we will pay that which we have vowed.

**39.** Our souls do magnify Thee, O Lord.

40. And our spirits have rejoiced in Thee, our Saviour.

**41.** For Thou hast regarded our low estate: For behold, all generations shall call us blessed.

**42.** For Thou Who art mighty hast done to us great things; & holy is Thy Name.

**43.** And Thy mercy is upon us who fear Thee from generation to generation.

**44.** Thou hast shown strength with Thine arm; Thou hast scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts.

**45.** Thou hast put down the mighty in their seats, & exalted them of low degree.

**46.** Thou hast filled the hungry with good things; & the rich Thou hast sent empty away.

**47.** Blessed art Thou, O God, for Thou hast visited & redeemed Thy people.

**48.** And hath raised up an horn of Salvation for us in the house of Thy servant David.

**49.** That we should be saved from our enemies, & from the hand of all that hate us;

**50.** To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, & to remember Thy holy covenant.

**51.** Lord, Thou art God, which hast made Heaven, & Earth, & the sea, & all that in them is:

**52.** For of Thee, & through Thee, & to Thee, are all things: To Thee be glory for ever. Amen.

**53.** Now unto Thee, O Lord, be glory for ever & ever.

**54.** Unto Thee, O King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, be glory & honour for ever & ever.

55. We will declare Thy Name forever & sing praise unto Thee.

**56.** To Thee be praise & dominion for ever & ever.

**57.** To Thee be glory & majesty, dominion & power, now & forever.

**58.** We give glory to Thee, & worship Thee, O God.

**59.** Holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, & is, & is to come!

**60.** Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory & honour & power: For Thou hast created all things, & for Thy pleasure they are, & were created.

**61.** Thou wast slain, & hast redeemed us to God by Thy blood out of every kindred, & tongue, & people, & nation.

**62.** And hast made us unto our God kings & priests: & we shall reign on the Earth.

**63.** Worthy art Thou, O Lord, to receive power, & riches, & wisdom, & strength, & honour, & glory, & blessing.

64. Blessing, & honour, & glory, & power, be unto Thee that sitteth

upon the throne, & unto Thee, O Lamb of God, for ever & ever.

65. Salvation to Thee, O God, which sitteth upon Thy throne.

**66.** Blessing, & glory, & wisdom, & thanksgiving, & honour, & power, & might be unto Thee, O God, for ever & ever. Amen.

**67.** We give Thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, & wast, & art to come; because Thou hast taken to Thee Thy great power, & hast reigned.

**68.** Great & marvellous are Thy works, Lord God Almighty; just & true are Thy ways, Thou King of saints.

**69.** Who shall not fear Thee, O Lord, & glorify Thy Name? For Thou only art holy: For all nations shall come & worship before Thee; for Thy judgments are made manifest.

**70.** We will praise Thee, O Lord, according to Thy righteousness: and will sing praise to Thy Name, O Lord, most High.

**71.** O Lord, our Lord, how excellent is Thy Name in all the Earth! Who hast set Thy glory above the heavens.

**72.** We will praise Thee, O Lord, with our whole heart; we will shew forth all Thy marvellous works.

**73.** We will be glad and rejoice in Thee: We will sing praise to Thy Name, O Thou most High.

**74.** When our enemies are turned back, they shall fall and perish at Thy presence.

**75.** Thou, Lord, shalt endure for ever: Thou hast prepared Thy throne for judgment.

**76.** Thou shalt judge the World in righteousness, Thou shalt minister judgment to the people in uprightness.

**77.** Thou shalt be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble.

**78.** And they that know Thy Name shall put their trust in Thee: For Thou hast not forsaken them that seek Thee.

**79.** We will sing praises to Thee, O Lord, we will declare among the people Thy doings.

**80.** We have trusted in Thy mercy; our heart shall rejoice in Thy Salvation.

**81.** We will sing unto Thee, O Lord, because Thou hast dealt bountifully with us.

82. Thou, Lord, art the portion of our inheritance and of our cup: Thou

maintainest our lot.

**83.** The lines are fallen unto us in pleasant places; yea, we have a goodly heritage.

**84.** We will bless Thee, Lord, Who hast given us counsel:

**85.** We have set Thee always before us: Because Thou art at our right hand, we shall not be moved.

**86.** Thou wilt shew us the path of life: In Thy presence is fullness of joy; at Thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

**87.** We will love Thee, O Lord, our strength.

**88.** Thou art our rock, and our fortress, and our deliverer; our God, our strength, in whom we will trust; our buckler, and the horn of our Salvation, and our high tower.

**89.** We will call upon Thee, Who art worthy to be praised:

**90.** Thy way is perfect: Thy Word is tried: Thou art a buckler to all those that trust in Thee.

**91.** It is Thou Who girdest us with strength, and makest our way perfect.

**92.** We will give thanks unto Thee, O Lord, among the heathen, and sing praises unto Thy Name.

**93.** The heavens declare Thy glory, O God; and the firmament sheweth Thy handywork.

**94.** Thy law, O Lord, is perfect, converting the soul: Thy testimonies are sure, making wise the simple.

**95.** Thy statutes are right, rejoicing the heart: Thy commandments are pure, enlightening the eyes.

**96.** Thy fear is clean, enduring for ever: Thy judgments are true and righteous altogether.

**97.** More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.

**98.** Moreover by them are Thy servants warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward.

**99.** We will rejoice in Thy Salvation, and in Thy Name we will set up our banners:

**100.** We will joy in Thy strength, O Lord; and in Thy Salvation how greatly shall we rejoice!

**101.** For Thou hast given us our heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of our lips.

**102.** Be Thou exalted, O Lord, in Thine Own strength: So will we sing and praise Thy power.

**103.** Blessed be Thy Name, O Lord, because Thou hast heard the voice of our supplications.

**104.** Thou art our strength and our shield; we trusted in Thee, and we are helped: Therefore our hearts greatly rejoice; and with our songs will we praise Thee.

**105.** We will extol Thee, O Lord; for Thou hast lifted us up, and hast not made our foes to rejoice over us.

**106.** O Lord our God, we will give thanks unto Thee for ever.

**107.** For Thy Word is right; and all Thy works are done in Truth.

**108.** We will bless Thee, Lord, at all times: Thy praise shall continually be in our mouths.

**109.** Our souls shall make their boast in Thee, Lord: The humble shall hear thereof, and be glad.

**110.** Our tongues shall speak of Thy righteousness and of Thy praise all the day long.

**111.** Many, O God, are Thy wonderful works that Thou hast done, and Thy thoughts which are to us-ward.

**112.** Thou wilt command Thy lovingkindness in the day time, & in the night Thy songs shall be with us, & our prayers unto Thee, our God.

**113.** We will praise Thee, the health of our countenance, and our God.

**114.** In Thee we will boast all the day long, and praise Thy Name for ever.

**115.** Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: The sceptre of Thy Kingdom is a right sceptre.

116. Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness:

**117.** Be exalted among the heathen, be exalted in the Earth.

**118.** We sing praises unto Thee, O God, we sing praises unto Thee, O King.

**119.** Thou, O Lord, art greatly exalted.

**120.** Thy right hand is full of righteousness.

**121.** Our tongues shall sing aloud of Thy righteousness.

**122.** Open Thou our lips; and our mouths shall shew forth Thy praise.

**123.** We will praise Thee for ever, because Thou hast done it: And we will wait on Thy Name; for it is good before Thy saints.

**124.** We will praise Thy Name, O Lord; for it is good.

**125.** For Thou hast delivered us out of all trouble: And our eyes have seen Thy desire upon our enemies.

**126.** We will call upon Thee; and Thou shalt save us.

**127.** Evening, and morning, and at noon, will we pray, and cry aloud: And Thou shalt hear our voices.

**128.** In Thee will we praise Thy Word.

**129.** In Thee have we put our trust: We will not be afraid what Man can do unto us.

130. We will render praises unto Thee.

**131.** Be Thou exalted, O God, above the heavens; let Thy glory be above all the Earth.

**132.** We will praise Thee among the people: We will sing unto Thee among the nations.

**133.** Be Thou exalted above the heavens: Let Thy glory be above all the Earth.

**134.** We will sing of Thy power; yea, we will sing aloud of Thy mercy in the morning: For Thou hast been our defence and refuge in the day of our trouble.

**135.** Unto Thee, O Lord our strength, will we sing: For Thou art our defence, and the God of our mercy.

**136.** Because Thy lovingkindness is better than life, our lips will praise Thee.

**137.** Thus will we bless Thee as long as we live: We will lift up our hands in Thy Name.

138. We declare Thy works, O God.

139. We shall be glad in Thee, O God, & shall trust in Thee.

140. We sing forth Thy honour, O Lord.

**141.** We worship Thee, and shall sing unto Thee, we bless Thy Name, O God.

**142.** Blessed art Thou, Who hast not turned away our prayers, nor Thy mercy from us.

**143.** Be Thou merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause Thy face to shine upon us.

144. Thou shalt bless us; and all the ends of the Earth shall fear Thee.

**145.** Blessed art Thou, O Lord, Who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our Salvation.

**146.** Thou Who art our God art the God of Salvation.

**147.** We bless Thee, O God, in the congregations, even Thy Name, O Lord, from the fountain of Israel.

**148.** We ascribe strength unto Thee, O God: Thy excellency is over Thy people, and Thy strength is in the clouds.

**149.** O God, Thou art terrible out of Thy holy places: Thou, the God of Israel art Thou Who giveth strength and power unto Thy people.

**150.** Let the Heaven and Earth praise Thee, the seas, and every thing that moveth therein.

**151.** But we will hope continually, and will yet praise Thee more and more.

**152.** Our mouths shall shew forth Thy righteousness and Thy Salvation all the day; for we know not the numbers thereof.

**153.** We will go in Thy strength, Lord God: We will make mention of Thy righteousness, even of Thine only.

**154.** O God, Thou hast taught us from our youth: And hitherto have we declared Thy wondrous works.

**155.** Now also when we are old and greyheaded, O God, forsake us not; until we have shewed Thy strength unto this generation, and Thy power to every one that is to come.

**156.** Thy righteousness also, O God, is very high, Who hast done great things: O God, Who is like unto Thee!

**157.** Thou shalt increase our greatness, and comfort us on every side.

**158.** We will also praise Thee with the psaltery, even Thy Truth, O

God: Unto Thee will we sing with the harp, O Thou Holy One of Israel.

**159.** Our lips shall greatly rejoice when we sing unto Thee; and our souls, which Thou hast redeemed.

**160.** Our tongues also shall talk of Thy righteousness all the day long: For they are confounded, for they are brought unto shame, that seek our hurt.

**161.** Blessed be Thy glorious Name for ever: Let the whole Earth be filled with Thy glory; Amen, and Amen.

162. We have put our trust in Thee, that we may declare all Thy works.

**163.** Thou art our King of old, working Salvation in the midst of the Earth.

**164.** The day is Thine, the night also is Thine: Thou hast prepared the light and the sun.

**165.** Thou hast set all the borders of the Earth: Thou hast made summer and winter.

**166.** Unto Thee, O God, do we give thanks, unto Thee do we give

thanks: For that Thy Name is near Thy wondrous works declare.

**167.** We will remember Thy works, O Lord, most High: Surely we will remember Thy wonders of old.

168. We will meditate also of all Thy work, and talk of Thy doings.

**169.** Thy way, O God, is in the sanctuary: Who is so great a God as our God?

**170.** Thou art the God that doest wonders: Thou hast declared Thy strength among the people.

**171.** Thou hast with Thine arm redeemed Thy people.

**172.** We Thy people and sheep of Thy pasture will give Thee thanks for ever: We will show forth Thy praise to all generations.

**173.** We will sing aloud unto Thee our strength: And make a joyful noise unto Thee.

**174.** Thou art the most High over all the Earth.

**175.** Righteousness shall go before Thee; and shall set us in the way of Thy steps.

**176.** All nations whom Thou hast made shall come and worship before Thee, O Lord; and shall glorify Thy Name.

**177.** For Thou art great, and doest wondrous things: Thou art God alone.

**178.** We will praise Thee, O Lord our God, with all our hearts: And we will glorify Thy Name for evermore.

**179.** For great is Thy mercy toward us: Thou hast delivered our souls from the lowest hell.

**180.** Thou, O Lord, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, long suffering, and plenteous in mercy and Truth.

**181.** We will sing of Thy mercies, O Lord, for ever: With our mouths will we make known Thy faithfulness to all generations.

**182.** Thy faithfulness shalt Thou establish in the very heavens.

**183.** And the heavens shall praise Thy wonders, O Lord: Thy faithfulness also in the congregation of the saints.

**184.** For who in the Heaven can be compared unto Thee? Who among the sons of the mighty can be likened unto Thee?

**185.** Thou art greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all them that are about Thee.

**186.** O Lord God of hosts, who is a strong Lord like unto Thee? or to Thy faithfulness round about Thee?

**187.** The heavens are Thine, the Earth also is Thine: As for the World and the fullness thereof, Thou hast founded them.

**188.** Thou hast a mighty arm: Strong is Thy hand, and high is Thy right hand.

**189.** Justice and judgment are the habitation of Thy throne: Mercy and Truth shall go before Thy face.

**190.** In Thy Name shall we rejoice all the day: And in Thy righteousness shall we be exalted.

**191.** For Thou art the glory of our strength: And in Thy favour we shall be triumphant.

**192.** For Thou art our defence; and Thou art our King.

**193.** Blessed be Thou for evermore. Amen, and Amen.

**194.** Lord, Thou hast been our dwelling place in all generations.

**195.** It is a good thing to give thanks unto Thee, O Lord, and to sing praises unto Thy Name, O most High:

**196.** To shew forth Thy lovingkindness in the morning, and Thy faithfulness every night,

**197.** Upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon the harp with a solemn sound.

**198.** For Thou, Lord, hast made us glad through Thy work: We will triumph in the works of Thy hands.

**199.** O Lord, how great are Thy works! and Thy thoughts are very deep. **200.** Thou, Lord, art most High for evermore.

**201.** For, lo, Thine enemies, O Lord, for, lo, Thine enemies shall perish; all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered.

**202.** Thou, Lord, reignest; Thou art clothed with majesty; Thou art clothed with strength, wherewith Thou hast clothed Thyself: The World also is stablished, that it cannot be moved.

**203.** Thy throne is established of old: Thou art from everlasting.

**204.** Thou on high art mightier than the noise of many waters, yea, than the mighty waves of the sea.

**205.** Thy testimonies are very sure: Holiness becometh Thine house, O Lord, for ever.

**206.** We will sing unto Thee, O Lord: We will make a joyful noise to Thee, the rock of our Salvation.

**207.** We will come before Thy presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto Thee with psalms.

**208.** For Thou art a great God, and a great King above all gods.

**209.** In Thy hand are the deep places of the Earth: The strength of the hills is Thine also.

**210.** The sea is Thine, and Thou hast made it: And Thy hands have formed the dry land.

**211.** We will worship before Thee and bow down: We kneel before Thee, O Lord, our Maker.

**212.** For Thou art our God; and we are the people of Thy pasture, and the sheep of Thy hand.

**213.** We will sing unto Thee a new song: We will sing unto Thee.

**214.** We will sing unto Thee, and shew forth Thy Name, we will show forth Thy Salvation from day to day.

**215.** We will declare Thy glory among the heathen, Thy wonders among all people.

**216.** For Thou art great, and greatly to be praised: Thou art to be feared above all gods.

**217.** For all the gods of the nations are idols: But Thou hast made the heavens.

**218.** Honour and majesty are before Thee: Strength and beauty are in Thy sanctuary.

**219.** We will give unto Thee, O Lord, we will give unto Thee glory and strength.

**220.** We will give unto Thee, Lord, the glory due unto Thy Name: We will bring an offering, and come into Thy courts.

**221.** We will worship Thee in the beauty of holiness: We will fear before Thee continually.

**222.** We will say among the heathen that Thou reignest: The World also shall be established that it shall not be moved: Thou shalt judge the people righteously.

**223.** Let the heavens rejoice, and let the Earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fullness thereof.

**224.** Let the field be joyful, and all that is therein: Then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice.

**225.** Before thee, Lord: For Thou comest, Thou comest to judge the Earth: Thou shalt judge the World with righteousness, and the people with Thy Truth.

**226.** Thou, Lord, reignest; let the Earth rejoice; let the multitude of isles be glad.

**227.** The heavens declare Thy righteousness, and all the people see Thy glory.

**228.** Thou, Lord, art high above all the Earth: Thou art exalted far above all gods.

**229.** We will rejoice in Thee, and will give thanks at the remembrance of Thy holiness.

**230.** We sing unto Thee a new song; for Thou hast done marvellous things: Thy right hand, and Thy holy arm, hast gotten Thee the victory.

**231.** Thou hast made known Thy Salvation: Thy righteousness hast Thou openly shewed in the sight of the heathen.

**232.** Thou reignest; let the people tremble: Thou sittest between the cherubims; let the Earth be moved.

**233.** Thou art great; and Thou art high above all the people.

**234.** Let them praise Thy great and terrible Name; for it is holy.

**235.** The king's strength also loveth judgment; Thou dost establish equity, Thou executest judgment and righteousness.

**236.** We exalt Thee, O God, and worship at Thy footstool; for Thou art holy.

**237.** We exalt Thee, O God, and worship at Thy holy hill; for Thou, the Lord our God, art holy.

**238.** Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands.

**239.** We will serve Thee with gladness: We will come before Thy presence with singing.

**240.** Thou, O Lord, art God, and it is Thou that hast made us, and not we ourselves; we are Thy people, and the sheep of Thy pasture.

**241.** We will enter into Thy gates with thanksgiving, and into Thy courts with praise: We will be thankful unto Thee, and bless Thy Name.

**242.** For Thou art good; & Thy mercy is everlasting; and Thy Truth endureth to all generations.

**243.** We will sing of mercy and judgment: Unto Thee, O Lord, will we sing.

**244.** Bless the Lord, O my soul; we will not forget all Thy benefits, O Lord!

**245.** Thou executest righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed.

**246.** Bless the Lord, ye His Angels, that excel in strength, that do His commandments, hearkening unto the voice of His Word.

**247.** Bless ye the Lord, all ye His hosts; ye ministers of His, that do His pleasure.

**248.** Bless the Lord, all His works in all places of His dominion: Bless the Lord, O my soul.

**249.** Bless the Lord, O my soul. O Lord our God, Thou art very great; Thou art clothed with honour and majesty.

**250.** O Lord, how manifold are Thy works! In wisdom hast Thou made them all: The Earth is full of Thy riches.

**251.** Thy glory, O Lord, shall endure for ever: Thou shalt rejoice in Thy works.

**252.** We will sing unto Thee as long as we live: We will sing praise to Thee, our God, as long as we live.

**253.** Our meditations of Thee shall be sweet: We will be glad in Thee, O Lord.

**254.** We will glory in Thy holy Name.

**255.** We will praise Thee, O God. We will give thanks unto Thee; for Thou art good: For Thy mercy endureth for ever.

**256.** Who can utter Thy mighty acts, O Lord? Who can shew forth all Thy praise?

**257.** We will give thanks unto Thee, O Lord, for Thou art good: & Thy mercy endureth for ever.

**258.** We, Thy redeemed, will say so, for Thou hast redeemed us from the hand of the Enemy;

**259.** And hast gathered us out of the lands, from the east, and from the west, from the north, and from the south.

**260.** Oh that men would praise Thee, for Thy goodness, and for Thy wonderful works to the children of men!

**261.** Thou satisfiest the longing soul, and fillest the hungry soul with goodness.

**262.** For Thou hast broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder.

**263.** Let us sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare Thy works with rejoicing.

**264.** Let us exalt Thee also in the congregation of the people, and praise Thee in the assembly of the elders.

**265.** O God, our hearts are fixed; we will sing and give praise, even with our glory.

**266.** Awake, psaltery and harp: We ourselves will awake early.

**267.** We will praise Thee, O Lord, among the people: And we will sing praises unto Thee among the nations.

**268.** For Thy mercy is great above the heavens: And Thy Truth reacheth unto the clouds.

**269.** Be Thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: And Thy glory above all the Earth;

**270.** That Thy beloved ones may be delivered: Save with Thy right hand, and answer us.

**271.** We will greatly praise Thee, O Lord, with our mouths; yea, we will praise Thee among the multitude.

**272.** For Thou shalt stand at the right hand of the poor, to save him from those that condemn his soul.

**273.** Praise ye the Lord. We will praise Thee with our whole hearts, in the assembly of the upright, and in the congregation.

**274.** Thy works, O Lord, are great, sought out of all them that have pleasure therein.

**275.** Thy work is honourable and glorious: And Thy righteousness endureth for ever.

**276.** Thou hast made Thy wonderful works to be remembered: Thou art gracious and full of compassion.

**277.** Thou hast given meat unto them that fear Thee: Thou wilt ever be mindful of Thy covenant.

**278.** Thou hast shewed Thy people the power of Thy works, that Thou mightest give us the heritage of the heathen.

**279.** The works of Thy hands are verity and judgment; all Thy commandments are sure.

**280.** They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in Truth and uprightness.

**281.** Thou hast sent redemption unto Thy people: Thou hast commanded Thy covenant for ever: Holy and reverend is Thy Name.

**282.** The fear of Thee, O Lord, is the beginning of wisdom: A good understanding have all they that do Thy commandments: Thy praise endureth for ever.

**283.** We praise Thee, O Lord. We, Thy servants, praise Thee. We praise Thy Name.

**284.** We bless Thy Name, O Lord, from this time forth and for evermore.

**285.** From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same Thy Name, O Lord, is to be praised.

**286.** Thou art high above all nations, and Thy glory above the heavens.

**287.** Who is like Thee, O Lord our God, Who dwelleth on high,

**288.** Who humbleth Thyself to behold the things that are in Heaven, and in the Earth!

**289.** Thou raisest up the poor out of the dust, and lifteth the needy out of the dunghill;

**290.** That Thou mayest set him with princes, even with the princes of Thy people.

**291.** Thou makest the barren woman to keep house, and to be a joyful mother of children. We praise Thee, our God.

**292.** We love Thee, O Lord, because Thou hast heard our voice and our supplications.

**293.** Because Thou hast inclined Thine ear unto us, therefore will we call upon Thee as long as we live.

**294.** For Thou hast delivered our souls from death, our eyes from tears, and our feet from falling.

**295.** Thou hast loosed our bonds.

**296.** We will offer to Thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon Thee.

**297.** For Thy merciful kindness is great toward us: And Thy Truth endureth for ever. We will praise Thee, O Lord.

**298.** Thou art our strength and our song, and art become our Salvation.

**299.** Thy right hand is exalted: Thy right hand doeth valiantly.

**300.** We will praise Thee: For Thou hast heard us, and art become our Salvation.

**301.** Thou art the Lord, which hath shown us light:

**302.** Thou art our God, and we will praise Thee: Thou art our God, we will exalt Thee.

**303.** Thy testimonies have we taken as an heritage for ever: For they are the rejoicing of our hearts.

**304.** We love Thy commandments above gold; yea, above fine gold.

**305.** We esteem all Thy precepts concerning all things to be right; and we hate every false way.

306. Thy testimonies are wonderful: Therefore do our souls keep them.307. The entrance of Thy Words giveth light; it giveth understanding

unto the simple.

**308.** Righteous art Thou, O Lord, and upright are Thy judgments.

**309.** Thy testimonies are righteous and very faithful.

**310.** Thy Words are very pure: Therefore Thy servants love them.

**311.** Consider how we love Thy precepts: Quicken us, O Lord, according to Thy lovingkindness.

**312.** Thy Word is true from the beginning: And every one of Thy righteous judgments endureth for ever.

**313.** We rejoice at Thy Word, as those who find great spoil.

**314.** We love Thy testimonies exceedingly.

**315.** Thy law is our delight.

**316.** Our help cometh from the Lord, which made Heaven and Earth.

**317.** Thou hast done great things for us; whereof we are glad.

**318.** We will go into Thy tabernacles: We will worship at Thy footstool.

**319.** Behold, bless ye the Lord, all ye servants of the Lord, which by night stand in the house of the Lord.

**320.** Lift up your hands in the sanctuary, and bless the Lord.

**321.** Thou, O Lord, Who hast made Heaven and Earth, bless us out of Zion.

**322.** Praise ye the Lord. Praise ye the Name of the Lord; praise him, O ye servants of the Lord.

**323.** Ye that stand in the house of the Lord, in the courts of the house of our God.

**324.** We praise Thee, O God, for Thou art good: We sing praises unto Thy Name; for it is pleasant.

**325.** For Thou hast chosen us unto Thyself, and Thy people for Thy peculiar treasure.

**326.** For we know that Thou art great, and that Thou, O God, art above all gods.

**327.** Whatsoever pleased Thee, that Thou didst in Heaven, and in Earth, in the seas, and all deep places.

**328.** Thy Name, O Lord, endureth for ever; and Thy memorial, O Lord, throughout all generations.

**329.** We give thanks, O Lord, unto Thee; for Thou art good: For Thy mercy endureth for ever.

**330.** We give thanks unto Thee, Thou God of gods: For Thy mercy endureth for ever.

**331.** We give thanks to Thee, Thou Lord of lords: For Thy mercy endureth for ever.

**332.** To Thou Who alone doest great wonders: For Thy mercy endureth for ever.

**333.** To Thou Who by wisdom made the heavens: For Thy mercy endureth for ever.

**334.** We will praise Thee with our whole heart: Before the gods will we sing praise unto Thee.

**335.** We will worship toward Thy holy temple, and praise Thy Name for Thy lovingkindness and for Thy Truth: For Thou hast magnified Thy Word above all Thy Name.

**336.** In the day when we cried Thou hast answered us, and hast strengthened us with strength in our soul.

**337.** All the kings of the Earth shall praise Thee, O Lord, when they hear the Words of Thy mouth.

**338.** Yea, they shall sing in Thy ways, O Lord: For great is Thy glory.

**339.** Though Thou art high, yet hast Thou respect unto the lowly: But the proud Thou knowest afar off.

**340.** We will praise Thee; for we are fearfully and wonderfully made: Marvellous are Thy works; and that our souls know right well.

**341.** How precious also are Thy thoughts unto us, O God! how great is the sum of them!

**342.** If we should count them, they are more in number than the sand: When we awake, we are still with Thee.

**343.** We will extol Thee, our God, O king; and we will bless Thy Name for ever and ever.

**344.** Every day will we bless Thee; and we will praise Thy Name for ever and ever.

**345.** Great art Thou, and greatly to be praised; and Thy greatness is unsearchable.

**346.** One generation shall praise Thy works to another, and shall declare Thy mighty acts.

**347.** We will speak of the glorious honour of Thy majesty, and of Thy wondrous works.

**348.** And men shall speak of the might of Thy terrible acts: And we will declare Thy greatness.

349. They shall abundantly utter the memory of Thy great goodness,

and shall sing of Thy righteousness.

**350.** Thou art gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.

**351.** Thou art good to all: And Thy tender mercies are over all Thy works.

**352.** All Thy works shall praise Thee, O Lord; and Thy saints shall bless Thee.

**353.** They shall speak of the glory of Thy Kingdom, and talk of Thy power;

**354.** To make known to the sons of men Thy mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of Thy Kingdom.

**355.** Thy Kingdom is an everlasting Kingdom, and Thy Dominion endureth throughout all generations.

**356.** Thou upholdest all that fall, and raisest up all those that be bowed down.

**357.** The eyes of all wait upon Thee; and Thou givest them their meat in due season.

**358.** Thou openest Thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing.

**359.** Thou art righteous in all Thy ways, and holy in all Thy works.

**360.** Thou art nigh unto all them that call upon Thee, to all that call upon Thee in truth.

**361.** Thou wilt fulfil the desire of them that fear Thee: Thou also wilt hear their cry, and will save them.

**362.** Thou preservest all them that love Thee: But all the wicked Thou wilt destroy.

**363.** Our mouths shall speak of Thy praise, O Lord: And all flesh shall bless Thy holy Name for ever and ever.

364. We praise, O Lord. With our souls do we praise Thee.

**365.** While we live will we praise Thee, O God: We will sing praises unto Thee while we have any being.

**366.** We will praise Thee, O God: For it is good to sing praises unto Thee, O God; for it is pleasant; and praise is comely.

**367.** Thou dost build up Jerusalem: Thou gatherest together the outcasts of Israel.

**368.** Great art Thou, O Lord, and of great power: Thy understanding is infinite.

**369.** Thou hast strengthened the bars of our gates; Thou hast blessed our children within us.

**370.** Praise ye the Lord. Praise ye the Lord from the heavens: Praise Him in the heights.

**371.** Praise ye Him, all His Angels: praise ye Him, all His hosts.

**372.** Praise ye Him, sun and moon: praise Him, all ye stars of light.

**373.** Praise Him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that be above the heavens.

**374.** Let them praise the Name of the Lord: for He commanded, & they were created.

**375.** We will praise the Name of the Lord: For Thy Name alone is excellent; Thy glory is above the Earth and Heaven.

**376.** Thou also exalteth the horn of Thy people, the praise of all Thy saints; even of the children of Israel, a people near unto Thee. Praise ye the Lord.

**377.** We will praise Thee, O Lord. We will sing unto Thee a new song, and Thy praise in the congregation of saints.

**378.** We will rejoice in the Lord that made us: & we will be joyful in Thee, our King.

**379.** We will praise Thee in the dance: We will sing praises unto Thee with the timbrel and harp.

**380.** For Thou dost take pleasure in Thy people: Thou wilt beautify the meek with Salvation.

**381.** Let us be joyful in glory: We will sing aloud on our bed.

**382.** The high praises of Thee, O God, will be in our mouth, and a two-edged sword in our hand;

**383.** To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and punishments upon the people;

**384.** To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron;

**385.** To execute upon them the judgment written: This honour have we Thy saints. Praise ye the Lord.

**386.** We praise Thee, O God. We praise Thee in Thy sanctuary: We praise Thee in the firmament of Thy power.

**387.** We praise Thee for Thy mighty acts: We praise Thee according to Thy excellent greatness.

**388.** We praise Thee with the sound of the trumpet: We praise Thee with the psaltery and harp.

**389.** We praise Thee with the timbrel and dance: We praise Thee with

stringed instruments and organs.

**390.** We praise Thee upon the loud cymbals: We praise Thee upon the high sounding cymbals.

**391.** Let every thing that hath breath praise Thee, O Lord. Praise ye the Lord!

**392.** We praise Thee, O God. We glorify Thee, we magnify Thy Name. We honour Thee & we love Thee. We bow before Thee & with our whole hearts do we praise Thee & give Thee thanks.--In Jesus' name, amen.
